## Exhibition overview

2017 sees the Federation of European Societies for Surgery of the Hand joining force with European Federation of Societies for Hand Therapy for a joint congress.

Hand surgery is a highly specialised field dealing with injury, disease, degeneration, or congenital disorders of the hand, forearm and elbow. The training of a hand surgeon in most FESSH member countries follows basic training in plastic or orthopaedic surgery. Based on these more general surgical experience, the hand surgeon is then developed. This implies the knowledge of bone surgery, joint surgery, tendon surgery, micro surgery, arthroscopy, peripheral nerve surgery and management of soft tissue defects with vascular pedicled flaps. In addition, special knowledge is required in the field of congenital malformations or systemic diseases (eg. rheumatoid arthritis, scleroderma ) where hand surgery is only one part of a more complex therapy.
