Exhibition overview

The specialty of internal medicine covers a wide range of conditions affecting the internal organs of the body - the heart, the lungs, the liver and gastro-intestinal tract, the kidneys and urinary tract, the brain, spinal column, nerves, muscles and joints. Although some diseases specifically affect individual organs, the majority of common diseases - arteriosclerosis, diabetes, high blood pressure and cancer may affect many internal organs of the body. The internist must then be trained to recognize and manage a very broad range of diseases.

The European Federation of Internal Medicine (EFIM) is a scientific organisation founded in 1996 to provide a scientific organisation of internal medicine on a European basis. EFIM was formed by bringing together the national societies of internal medicine in each of the European countries, both inside and outside the European Union. EFIM currently comprises 33 member societies representing over 30,000 internists.

The Federation holds a European medical Congress in a European capital or a large city in association with the National Society of the country concerned. Important medical topics will be discussed there by the best European specialists in their field. In 2014, this will take place in Geneva.
